2. What predispositions did you and/or your horse possess in order to make this talent a success?
3. What sequence of steps needed to be taken in order for you to teach your horse/pony this talent?
4. What rewards or incentives were most useful to facilitating this talent?
5. Did you experience any setbacks? What were they? How did you refocus your horse?

Please reread and share this writing with several non-horse people. They will give you specific feedback on what they don't understand. Make changes to your writing accordingly. This writing will be read out loud to Fair Goers during your presentation of the talent. Please remember to include your full name, and your horse's name in your writing.

Have fun! Step up to this challenge, and you will bask in the glory of your hard work. “Good luck” and “May the horse be with you”.
