OPEN WALK-TROT CLASSES COUNT TOWARD HIGH POINT FOR ALL DIVISIONS

4 HIGH POINT AWARDS: \$2 HIGHPOINT entry fee paid by class 14.

Senior Classes: 11, 16, 19, 21, 25, 28, 31, 32, 38, 44, 48

Junior Classes: 12, 17, 19, 21, 26, 28, 31, 32, 39, 44, 49

Childrens Classes: 13, 18, 19, 21, 27, 28, 31, 32, 40, 44, 50

Walk Trot Classes: Classes (11, 12, or 13), 14 or 15, 21, 22 or 23, 33, 36 or 37, 44, 45 or 46

MINIMUM OF 5 PARTICIPANTS PER DIVISION REQUIRED.

2009 OPEN SHOW RULES

1. Original Negative Coggins test for current year to be shown at check-in and copy left with show office.
2. Age as of January 1st of the current year.
3. Judge's decision is final. Six placings will be given.
4. The Show Committee may make necessary changes to the class list. Classes may be combined or cancelled because of lack of entries.
5. The Show Committee, WC 4-HHA, and Exposition Center accept no responsibility for the loss or destruction of property or equipment or for damages to or by animals on exhibition at these show grounds or show area.
6. No entry refunds unless the class is cancelled or an injury or illness is verified by a veterinarian or the Show Committee.
7. Intoxication, disrespect for the rules, undue punishment, or mishandling of the horse or pony, at the discretion of the judge and the Show Committee will be cause for disqualification for any or all events and to cancellation of awards or prizes without claims for damages.
8. Stallions to be under control at all times. No one under 18 will be permitted to exhibit a stallion at this show except as a yearling at halter. USEF/WSHC rules pertaining to stallions will be followed.
9. Horses five (5) and under - bosals or snaffles will be allowed.
10. Appropriate attire and tack necessary in all classes, except where otherwise stated. **ASTM/SEI Helmet with harness is to be worn by anyone while mounted or driving a horse.** Even though Waukesha Expo does not require a helmet as standard practice, any 4-H activity, anything to do with 4-H, 4-H sponsors, 4-H co-sponsors or if 4-H is any way mentioned on the showbills, helmets need to be worn. Should people decide not to comply, they will be disqualified from the competition and asked to dismount.
11. Novice Halter - Horse who has not won 3 blue ribbons in a Halter class at previous open shows is eligible.
12. Novice Equitation - rider who has not won 3 blue ribbons in an Equitation class at previous open shows is eligible
13. Novice Pleasure - Horse who has not won 3 blue ribbons in a Pleasure class at previous open shows is eligible.
14. High Point trophies are given on a one horse - one rider combination. A tie for High Point trophy winner will be the combination winning the most blues reds, etc. in High Point Classes. A minimum of 5 participants in each division are required for High Point Awards to be given.
15. Ponies are 56" and under.
16. Sportsmanship and courtesy are EXPECTED at all times. Offenders may be asked to leave the show.
17. Riders MUST be ready at the gate 5 minutes prior to all classes or will be eliminated.
18. Three minutes will be allowed for tack changes.
19. **NO DOGS ALLOWED.**

Stalls \$20.00 is paid at the show office. You receive a paid stall tag, which you place on your stall door. Upon departure, strip and clean your stall. After approved inspection by the barn staff, you will receive your refund of \$5.00.
