

RULES

1. Shows Rules are based on WI STATE 4-H Horse Association Guidelines.
2. Show committee may make class changes as they deem necessary. Canter classes over 20 and Walk/Trot classes over 18 will be split.
3. Judges placing decision is final.
4. All Waukesha County 4-H horseless horse and horse and pony project members may ride their horses/ponies in either style of riding with proper attire and tack.
5. Western horses 5 years old and under, bosals or snaffles will be allowed.
6. No refunds unless illness or injury to horse or rider.
7. In lieu of possible danger to a 4-H member whose horse is out of control, anyone can come to the 4-H member's aid and settle the horse down in the practice ring so it is safe to ride. However, no one other than the 4-H member may ride their horse on the show grounds.
8. No coaching from show ring rail by parents, leaders or professional trainers/instructors.
9. ASTM/SEI Approved Helmets must be worn by all riders whenever riding or driving at all 4-H events. This rule was made by the State 4-H Association and must be adhered to by all riders.
10. All 4-H exhibitors and non-4-H show & clinic attendees must wear a helmet and proper footwear when leading or lunging a horse in any of the arenas – show ring or warm up arenas.

NO EXCEPTIONS

11. When a rider becomes dislodged or a horse gets loose, all riders are asked to dismount. Riders in ALL rings and on the grounds must dismount upon direction of the announcer.
12. Sportsmanship and courtesy are expected at all times. Any 4-H member exhibiting poor sportsmanship, arguing with a judge or demonstrating improper behavior, in any way, will be asked to leave and may be disqualified from exhibiting at future WC4-HHA sponsored shows.
13. Spectators need to stand back (at least 5 feet) from the rail of the show ring, for the safety of riders, horses and spectators.
