



Waukesha County 4-H Horse Association YEAR END AWARDS

Year-end awards are accumulated from the circuit shows that are held each year and alumni show. *You must complete the WC4-HHA Member Service Hour Requirement of 4 hours to be eligible for a year end award.*

Please keep in mind the following:

- 1.** Each horse and rider should have one number - either the number you were assigned last year, or the new one you will receive at the beginning of this year. The number you start with is the one you will use all year.
- 2.** Therefore, ONLY if you have two horses should you have two numbers. Your points are not combined between the two horses, instead each is calculated separately.
- 3.** Use the same name for your horse throughout the year in order to track total points awarded.
- 4.** Hippology counts towards the year end awards. If you have more than one horse, the points from hippology will be added to the horse with the most points. If there is a tie in total points, the tie will be broken by the 4-H member that received the most hippology points.
- 5.** Points are totaled at the end of the year and year end rankings are awarded in both Western and English divisions. Separate awards will be given out for driving, walk/trot and horseless horse participants. Points accumulated in the Lead line class will not count toward year-end awards. A 4-H individual can only win in one category.
- 6.** Please advise the awards committee if you should change from walk-trot to canter classes during the year.
- 7.** Points are allocated based on the amount of horses in a class. If there are more than 6 horses, first place receives 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 3 points, 5th place 2 points and 6th place 1 point. If a class only has 2 participants than first place would receive 2 points and 2nd place would receive 1 point.
- 8.** This year, points earned at the Waukesha County 4-H Alumni show WILL count toward year end awards. Please make sure you register on designated 4-H registration form (different color) when you sign up for classes at the alumni show. Also, please make sure you use the same back number at the alumni show for ease of tracking points. Points are accumulated on horse/rider combinations.
