



Waukesha County 4-H Horse Association YEAR END AWARDS

Year-end awards are determined by points accumulated from that year's circuit shows and at the Waukesha County Fair.

You must complete the WC4-HHA Member Service Hour Requirement of six (6) hours to be eligible for a year end award, as well as other criteria required to be a member in "good standing" as described in the Project Guidelines.

Please keep in mind the following:

1. **Each horse and rider combination should have one number** - either the number you were assigned last year, or the new one you will receive at the beginning of this year. The number you start with is the one you will use all year.
2. **ONLY use two numbers if you are showing two horses.** Your points are not combined between the two horses, instead each is calculated separately.
3. Hippology counts towards the year end awards. If you have more than one horse, the points from hippology will be added to the horse with the most points. If there is a tie in total points, the tie will be broken by the 4-H member that received the most hippology points.
4. Points are totaled at the end of the year and year end rankings are awarded in both Western and English divisions. Separate awards will be given out for driving, walk/trot, and horseless horse participants. A 4-H individual can only win in one category.
5. Please advise the awards committee if you should change from walk-trot to canter classes during the year.
6. Points are allocated based on the amount of horses in a class. If there are more than 6 horses, first place receives 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 3 points, 5th place 2 points and 6th place 1 point. If a class only has 2 participants, then first place would receive 2 points and 2nd place would receive 1 point.

Remember the 4-H Motto - To make the best better
