



# WC4HHA 2019 SCHOOLING SHOW

(For Waukesha County 4-H Members Only)

**Judge: Maureen Martin**

Start the 2019 show season off with an instructional schooling show. Get tips on what the judge is looking for, proper tack and turn out, legal bits, etc... Riding classes will start out with rail work followed by simple patterns. The focus will be on safety and control for the first spring show. Other topics of interest include ring etiquette, proper spacing between horses, how to get out of the pack and spread out, correcting your horse in a fair and safe manner and what to do if your horse acts up in a show ring.

**Beginner = First or Second Year of Showing**  
**Intermediate/Advanced = More than 2 Years of Showing**

2019 Negative Coggins Required. Bring your original and a copy to leave at the show office.

**Entry Fee \$15.00 to Ride All Day**

**Stall \$15.00 with a \$5.00 refund if stall is stripped**

**SHAVINGS ARE REQUIRED FOR STALLS**

**TRAILER IN / JUMP OUT FEE: \$10.00 per horse**



An ASTM/SEI Approved Helmet with harness and appropriate boots must be worn by all riders while mounted, driving or lunging.

**ALL exhibitors (including Leadline riders)**

**MUST be in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade or above.**

**Walk-Trot Classes are only for those HORSE/RIDER COMBINATIONS not showing in canter classes.**

**HORSE/RIDER COMBINATIONS showing Walk-Trot are NOT eligible for classes other than**

**Walk-Trot, Showmanship and Walk-Trot Trail.**

**DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED on the Waukesha County Fair Grounds.**

## RULES

- ❖ Patterns for trail, showmanship, and equitation, if available, will be posted at the show office.
- ❖ Up to 6 Ribbons will be awarded in each class.
- ❖ Year End Awards will be awarded to the top Western riders and top English riders, the top Walk-Trot, English/Western Riders, and the top Horseless Horse Riders. Points will be kept on horse/rider combination USE THE SAME NUMBER ALL YEAR per horse/rider combination. Limit one award per rider.
- ❖ All 4-H exhibitors must have shown in at least one 4-H Circuit Show and have attended at least four additional clinics approved by the WC4HHA to show at & be considered a member in good standing & be eligible to compete at the WI State 4-H Horse Expo (in addition to receiving a blue ribbon in a state qualifying class).
- ❖ Members enter their animals at their own risk and agree to make no claims against the Waukesha County 4-H Horse Association, WC 4-H Leaders Association or Waukesha County Expo Center or any individual for personal injury, damage or loss of animals or articles.
- ❖ Pony size is 56" or under. If in doubt, have pony measured.

1. Shows will follow the rules of the Wisconsin State Horse Council unless stated otherwise.
2. Show committee may make class changes as they deem necessary.
3. Canter classes over 20 and Walk/Trot classes over 18 will be split.
4. Judge's placing decision is final.
5. The Ringmaster is the only liaison for the judge during the show.
6. Any youth or adult with questions for the judge, prior to the beginning of their class, will use the Ringmaster as the line of communication with the judge. Procedure: 1-Approach the Gate Keeper. 2-Gate Keeper will signal the Ringmaster. 3-Ringmaster will approach the gate, at which time the question can be asked. 4-Ringmaster will relay the question to the judge.
7. Sportsmanship and courtesy are expected at all times. Any 4-H member or adult exhibiting poor sportsmanship, arguing with a judge or demonstrating improper behavior, in any way, will be asked to leave and may be disqualified from exhibiting at future WC4-HHA sponsored shows.
8. There will be no coaching from the show ring rail.
9. All Waukesha County 4-H horseless horse and horse and pony project members may ride their horses/ponies in either style of riding with proper attire and tack.
10. Western horses 5 years old and under, bosals or snaffles will be allowed.
11. No refunds unless illness or injury to horse or rider.
12. In lieu of possible danger to a 4-H member whose horse is out of control, anyone can come to the 4-H member's aid and settle the horse down in the practice ring so it is safe to ride. However, no one other than the 4-H member may ride their horse on the show grounds.
13. ASTM/SEI Approved Helmets must be worn by all riders whenever riding or driving at all 4-H events. This rule was made by the State 4-H Association and must be adhered to by all riders.
14. Horse/Rider combination - Beginner equals 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year of showing. Intermediate/Advanced equals more than 2 years of showing.
15. A horse is not allowed to practice the trail pattern. Thus, a horse can only be ridden through the trail pattern once. If a horse has 2 riders, only 1 rider will be allowed to participate in trail. If parents/alumni want to participate with a member's horse, the parent/alumni must go second.
