The Waukesha 4-H horse project provides county-wide clinics that you are strongly encouraged to attend in order to learn more about horse care, safety, and showing your horse. Members must attend a minimum number of clinics each year to qualify for year-end awards and be eligible to show at the State 4-H Horse Show. In addition, attending clinics is a great way for 4-H members & their parents to meet other 4-H horse project members, parents, leaders, and get involved.
